Construction Timeline

- August 2001 Began construction
- June 24, 2002 Opened 1,200 new parking spaces to public
- October 1, 2002 Opened additional 1,200 parking spaces to public
- March 28, 2003 Opened additional 1,606 spaces - facility completed and opened to the public

Cost

- The \$59 million budget was funded through a revenue bond approved by the City of Dallas.

Features

- New four-level covered garage provides 4,006 parking spaces, increasing total parking capacity to more than 7,000 spaces.
- Includes bright, 1,500-foot climate-controlled pedestrian concourse complete with ten moving walkways and public art installation.
- Garage design offers exceptional lighting, improved pedestrian and vehicle mobility along with an overall upgrade in service to Love Field customers.
- Skybridge offers easy access to main terminal.
- Six elevators service three Garage B locations.
- Two elevators and two escalators carry passengers down two stories to the main check-in lobby.
- New Garage B rate - up to \$7.00 per day.
- ADA accessible parking spaces are available.
- Garage B = 1,447,584 square feet
- Concourse = 49,975 square feet
- Skybridge = 2,420 square feet
